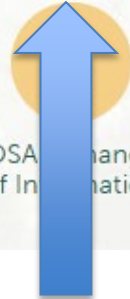

Requests are processed every other Tuesday. Students should receive the refund into their bank account within 14 business days of submitting the request.

Deposits can only be made to Canadian institutions.
